

Some are cultivating the homogenous ...

But we do not believe in the idea of an "ethnically clean culture". All cultures develop by mutual influence. Therefore we believe in diversity, intercultural understanding and friendship among the peoples of the world.

Some want to split up ...

But we don't! We do not believe that there is a cultural contradiction between ethnic Danes and immigrants. We believe that the majority of immigrants and refugees want to live in peace and understanding with their Danish fellow citizens.

Some are creating images of hostility ...

We do not think the world needs more hostile stereotypes. Immigration and refugee politics are questions that can be discussed, but xenophobia does not lead anywhere. And racism is a crime against humanity and is poison to democracy.

For these reasons SOS against Racism wants – through information and other non-violent actions - to state this principle:

All men are equal regardless of colour of skin, language, nationality, ethnic or cultural background or religious beliefs!

In our organization we are working for dialogue and understanding among human beings. We are working to expose and combat discrimination.

SOS Racism in Europe, Africa, Northern and Southern Americas is independent of party politics. SOS against Racism in Denmark is a nationwide organization with autonomous local branches in Copenhagen and Randers. New branches are always welcome.

SOS against Racism always needs more members and more activities. We wish to spread our message and to influence public opinion.

Our logo - the yellow hand - is open and symbolizes friendship.
